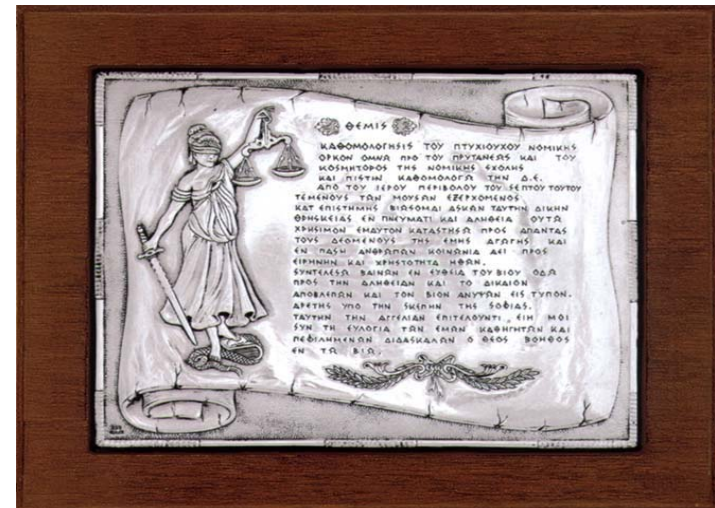

**Libraries of Faculty of Law are open access, non-lending libraries, serving not only the academic community, but external users as well.**

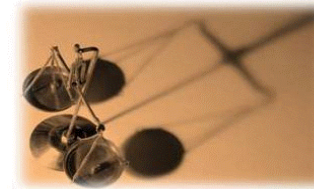
## SERVICES

Via **UOA** Libraries website <http://www.lib.uoa.gr> there is immediate access:

- to online Public Access Catalogue (**OPAC**) of **UOA** Libraries
- to **online databases and electronic journals** in which **UOA** is subscriber (only via **UOA Libraries**)
- to electronic journals and to a number of bibliographic and full-text databases services of the **HEAL-LINK** consortium
- to bibliographical information resources in Greece and worldwide via «**ARGO**» access environment
- to catalogues of Greek Academic Libraries via portal «**ZEPHYR**»
- to Hellenic Serials Union Catalogue «**EKT**» (**National Documentation Center**).
- to National and International Law Databases:
  - «**Isokratis**» / Athens Bar Association
  - «**NOMOS**» (access only via Law Libraries's facilities restricted per day and hours, as per the rules of each individual Library)
  - **LawNet.gr** Legal search engines
  - **Greek Government Gazette**
  - **Westlaw International**
  - **Beck-online**
  - **Hein-online**

## Inter - library loan

There is the possibility for users to order articles, that are not available in the Faculty of Law Libraries, from Greek Academic and Special Libraries via the National Documentation Centre and the British Library. (This service offered temporarily only through the **Library of Civil Law**).



## Library Regulation

- Users are required to put their personal belongings in lockers outside the library.
- In order to avoid disturbance to other users, quiet and good order must be maintained in all Library areas (including reading areas).
- Users are not allowed to download data or delete program files.
- In order for items to be reshelved, (except periodicals), they must be placed on the trolleys or the studying tables of the floor they were taken from.
- Users can make copies inside or outside the Library (depending on rules of each individual library) and only for educational use. Items are only used for personal reading. The systematic saving, coping and commercial use of items is forbidden. Users cannot copy a whole book, as this is prohibited by the law.
- To maintain a clean environment in the Library, eating and drinking are prohibited. Smoking is strictly forbidden. To secure peace of mind of users, mobile phones should be switched off.
